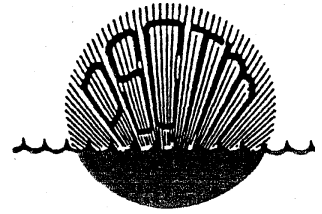


ANNOUNCEMENT

THE RITA LOWE SCHOLARSHIP



High School Division

The Washington State Mathematics Council and the Puget Sound Council of Teachers of Mathematics are proud to offer again the Rita Lowe Scholarship program.

For the 2009-2010 academic year, there will be one \$1000 scholarship awarded to a graduating high school student, and possibly a second \$1000 scholarship at the selection committee's discretion.

Any senior graduating from a high school in the State of Washington who is planning to attend a college or university within Washington State, and is planning to major in Mathematics Education and pursue teaching certification in order to become a professional mathematics educator (eg. a math teacher - elementary or secondary) is eligible to apply for the High School Division Scholarship.

Any eligible high school applicants must use the following application. The application form may be downloaded (www.wsmc.net) printed, and/or copied as needed. Applicants are to complete the application form and return that form and all other required documentation (outlined in the description following), postmarked by May 15, 2010 to:

In making the selection of the recipient, the committee will give consideration to academic achievement, demonstrated intent to pursue mathematics education, academic potential, character, and leadership potential.

APPLICATION PROCEDURES

1. The applicant should request that an official transcript documenting all high school work and SAT or ACT scores be submitted to Pat Reistroffer at the address given above.
2. The applicant should complete the application form and send it accompanied by the 300 - word statement and the list and description of academic awards and honors, to the same address.
3. The applicant should request that the two required letters of recommendation be submitted to the same address.
